Aid Stations: Electrolytes and water will be available on the 13.1 mile course. It is highly recommended runners carry a water bottle on the 13.1 mile course if warm temperatures exist on race day. Water, electrolytes and fruit will be available at the finish line as well. Medical assistance will be available throughout the races.

The Courses: all races will start and finish near the Ginger Bread House in Moore Park.

13.1 mile run: Course will start in Moore Park and gradually climb to the course's highest point, the radio towers on KAGO Hill. 80% of the course will be on dirt trail and in remote areas of KAGO Hill. The trail is 70% single track, with some areas having lots of rocks along the trail. The elevation will range from 4200' to 5000' with lots of ascent and decent along the way. The trail will be clearly marked through Moore Park and once the course leaves the pavement.

3.1 mile run/walk: Course will start in Moore Park and utilize the trails around the perimeter of the Park. Most of the trails will be single track and have minimal elevation change.

Weather Conditions: Klamath Falls weather is generally in the 50's on September mornings. Runners should come prepared for extremes: lows of 30 and highs in the mid 80's.

Packet Pick Up: Packets can be picked up at the tennis court parking lot at Moore Park on Saturday September 25th, 2010 between 3PM & 7 PM or on race day at the start/finish line registration table from 6:30-7:30am.
